Question for written answer E-008902/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Vicky Maeijer (NI)

Subject: Serious damage caused to the transport industry by illegal aliens

The stakeholder organisation Transport en Logistiek Nederland is sounding the alarm about the growing number of illegal aliens who threaten HGV drivers, break into trucks and damage loads, with the inevitable economic consequences.¹

- 1. Does the Commission agree with the PVV that illegal aliens should be immediately be detained and deported from Schengen territory?
- 2. Can the Commission indicate whether it considers it fair that drivers have to work overtime because of a problem abetted by the Commission (importation of boatloads of illegal migrants via the Mediterranean), thus infringing the law on driving hours, and that those drivers and businesses are penalised for this?
- 3. Does the Commission, like the PVV, perceive that the situation with regard to illegal migrants, refugees, asylum-seekers, economic migrants or whatever euphemism we choose to use to refer to illegal aliens, is getting completely out of hand and damaging social cohesion, increasing crime and the threat of terrorism, and causing enormous economic damage to EU countries and hence to their people?
