Subject: Following the adoption of the resolution on the situation in Nagorno-Karabakh after Azerbaijan's attack and the continuing threats against Armenia

On 5 October 2023, Parliament voted during its plenary session in favour of an important resolution in support of the Armenian population of Nagorno-Karabakh following Azerbaijan's invasion of the region and the ethnic cleansing that followed.

The text contains several essential elements. Among other things, it calls for the EU to sanction Azerbaijan and its leaders and to suspend the memorandum of understanding on a strategic partnership in the field of energy between the EU and Baku.

- 2. Does the Commission still consider Azerbaijan to be a reliable and trustworthy partner?
