Subject: Transfer of social entitlements and pensions for mobile workers

In 2021, mobile workers accounted for 3.9 % of the European Union's workforce. The three leading nationalities among mobile workers are: Romanian, Polish and Italian. Unfortunately, many mobile workers are experiencing difficulties in repatriating or transferring their social entitlements and benefits (pensions, child allowances, unemployment benefits, etc.). Transferring these entitlements takes a long time and is sometimes obstructed by cumbersome bureaucratic procedures.

- 1. What measures is the Commission considering to ensure the effective implementation of EU rules on social security coordination and mobility, in order to facilitate easier transfer of social security benefits (pensions, child allowances, unemployment benefits, etc.) from one Member State to another?
- 2. What steps is the Commission considering to accelerate the digitalisation of social security systems to ensure fair mobility of the workforce in the EU?
