SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on International Trade calls on the Committee on Foreign Affairs, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions in its motion for a resolution:

1. Calls for a consistent approach to the PCA and FTA negotiations; recalls that each must support the other's objectives;
2. Emphasises that the two negotiations should be dependent on each other and be carried out in parallel;
3. Recalls that progress in the political area is instrumental to free and fair trade, just as much as trade liberalisation is helpful in promoting political liberalisation, democracy and human rights;
