Subject: 2023 UN Climate Change Conference in Dubai, United Arab Emirates (COP28)

In order to ensure a COP28 outcome that significantly advances the agenda in terms of mitigation, adaptation, finance and loss and damage, the EU must enhance its climate diplomacy, lay the groundwork for COP28 and lead by example. - 3. stepping up the global deployment of renewable energy while phasing out fossil fuels?
