Subject: Infringement proceedings under Article 258 TFEU and halting extraditions to Hungary

As a follow-up to the written answer to question E-001970/2024¹, could the Commission answer the following:

1. From which eight Member States has it not yet received information on the follow-up to the recommendation of 8 December 2022 on the procedural rights of suspects and the accused in pre-trial detention and on material detention conditions?
2. How many letters of formal notice and infringement proceedings under Article 258 TFEU did it issue against Hungary and Germany in relation to the European Arrest Warrant – and in what time period – in each of 2023 and 2024, and which concerned detention conditions or the right to a fair trial?
3. Does it believe that non-binary people detained in Hungary are sufficiently protected and is it in favour of halting extraditions to Hungary?
