Subject: Consequences of the conclusion of negotiations on the EU-Mercosur Partnership

Agreement

Negotiations on the EU-Mercosur Partnership Agreement were concluded on 6 December 2024. In Poland, as well as in other countries with major agricultural sectors, this development raises significant concerns about increased imports of cheaper products, as well as lower food protection standards. European farmers are contending with excessively stringent requirements imposed by the Green Deal, while Poland is also facing increased imports of agricultural goods from Ukraine. Polish farmers are also also concerned about the 'destruction of Polish forests and the hunting sector', as well as potential damage to the Polish economy. All these factors are fuelling numerous protests and giving rise to a desire to block the ratification of the agreement with Mercosur.

In this context:

- 1. Will the Commission provide compensatory measures for farmers, in particular for farmers from countries with major agricultural sectors?
- 2. Will the Commission provide protective measures for European farmers?
