Subject: Employment of Philippe Lamberts

As a follow-up to the written answer to question P-001948/2024, could the Commission answer the following:

1. In the event that it has not already done so, does the Commission plan to hire Philippe Lamberts, former Co-chair of the Group of the Greens/European Free Alliance, directly or engage him indirectly in a paid advisory role in the future?
2. If he is not to be hired directly or as a paid consultant, why has the Commission decided against employing Mr Lamberts when the creation of a new post of special adviser has already been discussed?
3. What terms and conditions, covering working hours, commencement date, duration, remuneration and possible additional benefits, have been established for Mr Lamberts' employment in the event that he is to be offered a job or paid consultancy role?
