Subject: Moldovan as a working language on the Commission website

Moldovan could be selected as a working language in the Consultation on the Future of Europe section of the Commission website.

At the web address cited below¹, Moldovan could be selected alongside Romanian as a language that can be used in the consultation process launched by the Commission. This was subsequently changed, but a screenshot of the initial web page can be found in the following footnote².

In accordance with the December 2013 decision of the Constitutional Court in Chişinău, the official language of the Republic of Moldova is 'Romanian, not Moldovan based on the Latin alphabet', thereby giving constitutional status to the country's Declaration of Independence adopted in August 1991.

Can the Commission explain how Moldovan could appear as an option on the above web page?
