Joint motion for a resolution

6. ***Calls on the Member States to extend bans on the use of smoke- and aerosol-emitting products to key outdoor areas; considers that they may include outdoor restaurants and cafés, workplaces, areas close to healthcare facilities, educational establishments, healthcare and other care facilities, public transportation including bus and tram stops, train stations and platforms, airports and recreational areas and other areas of congregation or high congestion, taking into account the risks posed by exposure;***
