32a. Calls on the EU to take an even clearer stand that the Eastern Partnership is not a policy against Russia, thereby guarding against different interpretations and misunderstandings of what this policy is intended to achieve; believes that the Eastern Partnership is totally compatible with existing trade agreements and that it fully respects Russia's traditional relations with its partners and neighbours; points out that the Eastern Partnership does not imply NATO accession and is not intended to antagonise the Eurasian Customs Union; notes that it is, however, a guarantee of EU support to partner countries which face diplomatic and economic pressures in an attempt to undermine their sovereignty;
