

SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on Transport and Tourism calls on the Committee on Budgetary Control, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions in its motion for a resolution:

- 1. Welcomes the finding of the Court of Auditors that the accounts of the SESAR Joint Undertaking for the 2012 financial year are in order;
- 2. Notes that SESAR's annual budget for 2012 was EUR 148.7 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 107.3 million in payment appropriations, and that the implementation rates were 95% and 86.3% respectively;
- 3. Highlights the SESAR Joint Undertaking's vital role in coordinating and implementing research by the SESAR project, which is a pillar project of the Single European Sky; notes also that the SESAR project will soon enter its deployment phase, which should be monitored carefully by the European Commission and Member States to ensure that it is completed on schedule;
- 4. Underlines that the budget for the development phase of the SESAR project is 2,1 billion euro, to be provided in equal parts by the EU, Eurocontrol and the participating public and private partners.
- 5. Notes that the Court of Auditors refers to a technical review that, for some projects, reported gaps in the documentation of ex ante controls and the exchange of data and results between the SESAR and Clean Sky Joint Undertakings; calls on SESAR to ensure the proper coordination of its activities with those of Clean Sky for the projects they have in common;
- 6. Proposes that Parliament grant the Executive Director of the SESAR Joint Undertaking discharge in respect of the implementation of its budget for the financial year 2012;
