“The Erosion of Human Rights in a Secular Society? – Redefining the pillars of the Western Identity”

November 6th – 9th 2016

Villa "La Collina", Cadenabbia, Italy

Since the signing of the Treaty of Rome in 1957 that established the European Economic Community and initiated the ongoing process of European integration, western societies have undergone a rapid, drastic, and seemingly irreversible process of secularization. In this respect, one can talk about the emergence of a post-Christian western culture.

At the same time, the process of European integration, the eastward expansion of the European Union and the mass immigration of mostly Muslim refugees to the western world have triggered fundamental questions concerning a “western identity” and the role of Christianity within that identity. What constitutes the “Western world”? How and where should one draw the external territorial and the internal cultural boundaries of Europe? Has secularism failed or do we need more of it? Is religion a problem to solve or part of an answer? Is it a public or a private matter?

The aim of this conference is to shed light on all these arising questions and challenges that the western world is facing regarding secularization and religious identities.
