This letter is in response to your January 10, 2017 request for Federal Trade Commission (FTC) records. We notified you by letter dated February 10, 2017 that we were placing your request on hold pending receipt of your fee agreement limit by February 28, 2017. You sought dispute resolution concerning fees and subsequently submitted an appeal. Your appeal was denied on March 22, 2017. Because we have not received a response from you relative to a fee agreement, we have closed our file on the FOIA request. Closure of this file does not preclude you from submitting other requests in the future.

If you are not satisfied with this response to your request, you may appeal by writing to Freedom of Information Act Appeal, Office of the General Counsel, Federal Trade Commission, 600 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20580, within 90 days of the date of this letter. Please enclose a copy of your original request and a copy of this response.
