ORDER GRANTING SECOND AGREED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 2, 2023, non-party Google LLC (“Google”) filed a second motion to extend the time for it to file a motion to quash or limit a subpoena served on Google by Federal Trade Commission Complaint Counsel (“Motion”). Google states that Complaint Counsel and Google are engaged in ongoing negotiations as to the scope of document production and that further negotiations may narrow or eliminate areas of dispute. Google further states that Complaint Counsel agrees to the extension requested in the Motion.

Upon review and consideration of the Motion, the Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby ORDERED that Google’s deadline to file a motion to quash or limit Complaint Counsel’s subpoena is extended to March 9, 2023.
