



Information Returns Intake System (IRIS) Overview





TY23/FS24

The IRIS system began accepting Information Returns on Wednesday, January 10, 2024, via the Taxpayer Portal and Application to Application (A2A) filing channels.

Reminders:

- Starting TY23, if you have 10 or more information returns, you must file them electronically.
- ➤ Both IRIS and FIRE will accept Form 1099 Series for TY23.
 - You may transmit through both systems.
 - Do not file identical data through FIRE and IRIS as this will cause a duplicate filing and may result in penalty notices.



IRIS Intake

Application to Application (A2A)

- Allows for bulk filing of Information Returns.
- Submit transmissions directly from their application to the IRIS application
- > XML Format

Taxpayer Portal

- ➤ Allows small volume filers to file Information Returns directly to the IRS without the need for software.
- User Interface (UI)
- Manually enter data into the platform via user interface screens.
- Simple Form Upload
 - Issuers or transmitters can upload data files to the platform to prepopulate the user interface screens using Comma-separated Values (CSV).

Accessing IRIS

- > A user must sign in with an existing account or create a new account.
- ➤ Apply for an IRIS Transmitter Control Code (TCC).
- Once TCC is assigned you can sign into IRIS.



Transmitter Control Codes

- > TCCs are not interchangeable between intake systems.
 - > FIRE TCCs can only be used in FIRE.
 - ACA TCCs can only be used in AIR.
 - ➢ IRIS TCCs can only be used in IRIS.
- > A separate TCC is needed for each IRIS intake method a filer wants to use. .
 - Taxpayer Portal (User Interface) –Issuer/Transmitter TCC
 - > A2A -Issuer/Transmitter TCC
 - A2A -Software Developer TCC
- ➤ The system inadvertently allowed filers to use A2A TCCs in the Taxpayer Portal for TY22.
 - This has been corrected for TY23 and future years.




Assurance Testing System

TY23 IRIS ATS is available for testing.

- There are twenty criteria-based scenarios to choose from.
- You are required to submit and pass five scenarios in ATS before you may transmit to Production.
 - You may choose any five of the 20 scenarios.
 - Each scenario must include two unique recipients for a total of ten records.
- ➢ If your application was marked for CF/SF program at least one scenario should include this information.
- ➢ If you are filing corrections, a second transmission with one submission and one record is needed.
 - Use the 'UniqueRecordId' from one of the accepted scenarios to submit a correction.
- For an expedited review process, please submit one transmission with only five submissions.

Business Rules





Top Business Rules

S1H001

Phone Number in Issuer Detail must have a value.

- Submission1Header: Issuer Detail Phone Number is not present
- > Report error
- Informational error only. This error cannot be corrected. Include in future submissions.

SHAREDIRFORM014

If Person Name and TIN in Recipient Detail have a value, they must match the IRS database.

- > TIN Validation Error
- Report Error

SHAREDIRFORM015

If Business Name and TIN in Recipient Detail have a value, they must match the IRS database.

- > TIN Validation Error
- > Report Error

SMF018

If Business Name in Issuer Detail has a value, then TIN and Business Name must match IRS records.

- > TIN Validation Error
- Reject

FS1H001 001

If TIN in Recipient Detail is a duplicate of TIN in Recipient Detail on another record in the Submission, then Recipient Account Number must have a value and be unique within a submission.

- Report Error
- Recipient Account Number is needed on records with same recipient TIN




TIN Validation Errors

How is a Name/TIN mismatch identified?

- A Name/TIN combination is incorrect if it does not match, or cannot be found, on IRS or SSA files.
- ➤ A Name/TIN mismatch occurs when an individual name is submitted with a TIN not associated with the individual name provided.
- A TIN is not interchangeable with different names.
 - ➤ A business EIN must be used for a partnership, corporation, or non-disregarded Limited Liability Company (LLC).
 - An SSN must be used with an individual name.
- Transmission Accepted with Errors.
 - Filer is notified via the Acknowledgement.
 - Filer is expected to correct the data and submit corrections.
 - ➤ If corrections are not made, filer may receive a CP2100 or CP2100A Notice.
 - Penalties may apply.


Transmitter Control Codes (TCC)

The system inadvertently allowed filers to use A2A TCCs in the Taxpayer Portal for TY22.

This has been corrected for TY23

Update your IRIS Application for TCC if you:

- Selected and used the wrong transmission method in TY22.
- Need to make modifications to Role or Transmission Method Options.



Combined Federal/State Filing

SHAREDIRFORM024

- ➤ If CFSF Election Indicator is "yes", then at least one CFSF Election State Code must have a value
- This error is setting erroneously.
- ➤ Filers receive "accepted with errors" submissions when the information is correct.
- We are fixing the issue.
- No correction is needed from filer.



Corrections

SharedIRFORM006_001:

- ➤ If 'CorrectedInd' has a value of "1", then 'UniqueRecordId' must have a value.
- This error was setting erroneously in the Taxpayer Portal.
- This issue has been fixed.
- ➤ If this error was received and a correction has not been resubmitted, please try correction process again if it has not been accepted.



Corrections (cont.)

Row is "Greyed Out" in the "Make a Correction" Table

- ➤ To start the correction process, select the View Submitted Forms button on the Dashboard page to view all submitted forms.
- Select the check box next to the transmission you'd like to correct.
- ➤ After making your selection, click the Correct button.

Reasons a row that contains the Record ID that you wish to correct is "greyed out":

- > There has been a previous correction "accepted" for that record.
- > You have started a correction that needs to be completed.
 - These will appear on the Unsubmitted Forms page "In Progress".

If you've incorrectly selected a form for correction, you'll be able to delete the form from the View Unsubmitted Forms page.



Application Status: Signature Required

All authorized users listed on the application must have an ID.me account.

- Refer to <u>How to register for IRS online self-help tools | Internal</u> <u>Revenue Service</u>, for more information.
- Please be sure that all authorized users have set up an ID.me account **BEFORE** adding them to the application.

All Responsible Officials must sign in to their account and sign the application before it can be processed.

- All ROs need to go to <u>www.irs.gov/iris</u> to access the application.




Do you have a TCC for the wrong transmission method?


