

Paediatric Liver and multivisceral waiting list


1. Enter the Paediatric liver and multivisceral waiting list

Recipient -> Paediatric Liver and multivisceral waiting list



2. Paediatric Liver and multivisceral waiting list

When you enter the menu all paediatric liver and multivisceral patients active on the waiting list will be displayed.




The list is default sorted so that recipients who have cancer and thereby highest priority according to the exchange rules, will be listed in top. Followed by sorting on waiting time.

3. Diagnosis

Alle recipients -> specific recipient -> waiting list information


Diagnosis must be registered on the current waiting list entry. If no diagnosis is set, it will be interpreted as Cancer diagnosed = No.



4. Waiting for combined Liver-kidney transplantation

All recipients -> specific recipient -> waiting list information

When a paediatric recipient is waiting for a combined liver-kidney transplantation, it is very important that you state on the waiting list if the recipient can use a liver without a kidney or not.




Liver required only with kidney: No -> The paediatric recipient will appear on the list.

Liver required only with kidney: Yes -> The paediatric recipient will <u>not</u> appear on the list.

5. Waiting for multivisceral transplantation

When a paediatric recipient is waiting for a multivisceral transplantation you must state on the waiting list, which organs the recipient is waiting for and if the recipient should appear on the paediatric liver and multivisceral waiting list.



6. Print/save

If you wish to print/save the list, click on the 'Print' button and a pdf will be generated, which can be printed or saved.
